


Knottallow Hill Climb

A steep climb rising 160m in 1.2 miles.

Starting on a gentle rise situated just north of Ulverston on **Old Hall Road (B521)** adjacent to Stone Briggs Farm (the Alpaca Farm after Old Hall Farm), in line with telegraph pole BT 10L 98 71 on opposite side of road.



The course then turns left at the crossroads with Eller Riggs Brow and passes the Chiltern Seed Farm. The riders go through a narrow part between buildings and must obey marshals' instructions. The next section is extremely steep (25%) and narrow up to farm buildings. The road levels for a short time before another kick up to Knottallow Tarn (local fishing spot), then a lumpy roller coaster to the finish just before crest of brow approx. 400m from T junction at top, adjacent to gate post.



Where is it:

Stone Briggs Farm (Alpaca Farm) on Old Hall Road (B521) just north of Ulverston, Grid Ref: 281802, SatNav LA123 7PE.

Parking and Safety:

Parking is available along the verge of Old Hall Road for a few cars and (depending on anglers) parking near the top of the course at Knottallow Tarn. Locals are requested to park in or near the Gill and ride up to the start. Riders must take care in the narrows, especially where it becomes very steep. If riders wish to get back to the start whilst racing is underway, they will be directed on a short loop rather than back down the course.

Course details revised 2024, course shortened to bring finish away from T Junction at top of course.
